<p><u>PURPOSE OF THIS POLICY:</u> To prevent and/or control damages to municipal roads by regulating pipeline crossings.</p>		
<p><u>POLICY STATEMENT:</u> The Municipality will allow pipeline crossings of municipal roads under the following guidelines:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) crossings are to be made by the punching or boring method. b) all pipeline road crossings shall be a minimum of six feet (6') below the crown of the roadway or ERCB standards, whichever is the greater. c) all pipeline road crossings shall be a minimum of three feet, six inches (3' 6") below the road ditch or ERCB standards, whichever is the greater. <p>Requests for open cutting of any road allowance to accommodate a pipeline crossing must have the prior approval of Council. The Party requesting the cutting of a road allowance shall sign an agreement accepting full responsibility for maintenance and/or repair of said roadway for a period of two years commencing on the date the road cut was done.</p> <p>Council reserves the right to assess maintenance or repair charges for bored or punched road crossings, against the Party for whom the line was installed, for a period of one year from the date the crossing was installed.</p>
