



**MD of Peace No. 135 Rural Acreage Owner
Herbicide Weed Control Program**

The MD of Peace No. 135 Agricultural Service Board Rural Acreage Owner Weed Control Program was developed to assist acreage owners with the challenging task of performing weed control on a maximum area of two (2) acres/year. Herbicide applications will be conducted as time permits, with the knowledge that priority is always given to the municipal road right of way program. **The herbicide application cost will be \$200/hour.**

Release for Herbicide Application

I, the landowner, hereby grant permission for MD of Peace Agricultural Services Department to apply residual herbicide within the property listed below.

I, the landowner, understand that herbicide application will be conducted during early summer, late summer or early fall only if time and weather permits. This signed request shall include permission for MD of Peace staff to enter stated property for performing such related weed control work.

I, the landowner, understand that the MD of Peace Vegetation Control Technician or the Manager of Ag Services will determine which herbicide to apply, upon inspection of the area requested for weed control.

The following herbicide that may be chosen for your application are:

- Lontrel, Milestone, Clearview, Overdrive, Tordon 22 K and Navius

I understand that the above mentioned herbicides may be applied for purpose of this request. I understand that they may selectively target broadleaf plants, have residual and contain low toxicity. I hereby declare that I understand the effects and I agree to save harmless and indemnify the MD of Peace No. 135, its employees and agents, from and against all actions, suits, claims and demands arising in any manner whatsoever from activities associated with said herbicide application.
