Barbara Johnson, CAO, stated that there were written submissions from Alberta Transportation and that they are satisfied with the Area Structure Plan and that the County of Northern Lights has no objections to the Area Structure Plan.

Bill Mitchell commented that there is mention in clause 13.2 that there will be no walkway through the Public Utility Lot; however, Map #8 shows evidence of a path through the Public Utility Lot and he would like that path removed from the map. Adele Boucher requested the same thing in order to prevent unauthorized users from entering Wilderness Park from that area.

Alisha Mody addressed the concern as well, stating that the Municipal District does not have any interest in turning that area into a trail but in the future, the Municipa District can address it if so desired. She explained that this had to be done at this stage in the process, otherwise it could not be added at a later time due to the subdivision process. Council confirmed that at no time in the future will the Municipal District entertain the idea of creating a trail for quads, snowmobiles, etc. Should any change ever be considered, they would discuss this with the Grimshaw Ag Society and residents prior to proceeding.
