BYLAW NO. 3/2019 BEING A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF PEACE NO. 135 IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE RATES OF TAXATION TO BE LEVIED AGAINST ASSESSABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF PEACE NO. 135 FOR THE 2019 TAXATION YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Municipal District of Peace No.135, Province of Alberta, has prepared and adopted detailed estimates of the municipal revenues on March 28, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal expenditures and transfers set out in the budget for the Municipal District of Peace No.135 for 2019 total \$9,849,978; and

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal revenues and transfers from all sources other than taxation is estimated at \$6,857,747 and the balance of \$2,992,231 is to be raised by general municipal taxation; and
