#### **BYLAW NO. 4/2020**

# BEING A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF PEACE NO. 135 IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

For the purpose of establishing alternate methods for advertising statutory notices.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act* and other enactments, a municipality must give notice of certain bylaws, resolutions, meetings, public hearings or other things in accordance with section 606 of the *Municipal Government Act* by advertising in a newspaper or other publication circulating in the area, mailing or delivering a notice to every residence in the affected area or by another method provided for in a bylaw under section 606.1 of the *Municipal Government Act*;

**AND WHEREAS,** pursuant to section 606.1 (1) of the *Municipal Government Act*, a council may, by bylaw, provide for one or more methods, which may include electronic means, for advertising proposed bylaws, resolutions, meetings, public hearings and other things referred to in section 606 of the *Municipal Government Act*;

**AND WHEREAS**, Council is satisfied that the advertising method provided for in this Bylaw is likely to bring the matters so advertised to the attention of substantially all residents in the area to which the bylaw, resolution or other thing relates or in which the meeting or hearing is to be held;

**NOW THEREFORE,** the Council of the Municipal District of Peace No. 135, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

### **General:**

1. This Bylaw shall be cited as the "Advertising Bylaw".

#### **Advertising Method:**

- 2. Any notice of a bylaw, resolution, meeting, public hearing or other thing required to be advertised pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act or another enactment must:
  - a) be given, in accordance with the timelines prescribed in subsections 606(3) and (4); and
  - b) contain the information prescribed in subsection 606(5) and (6).
- 3. In addition to the advertising methods prescribed in S. 606(2), any notice of a bylaw, resolution, meeting, public hearing or other thing required to be advertised pursuant to the provisions of the *Municipal Government Act* or another enactment may alternatively be given by the following method:
  - a) electronically by posting the notice prominently on the Municipal District of Peace's official website <a href="https://www.mdpeace.com">www.mdpeace.com</a> plus:
  - b) electronically by posting the notice prominently on any of the Municipal District of Peace's official social media sites; and/or
  - c) mailing each of the landowners in the affected area a copy of the notice.

## Severability:

4. That should any provision of this Bylaw be invalid, then such invalid provision shall be severed and the remaining Bylaw shall be maintained.

## **Effective Date:**

5. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the third and final reading.
