TITLE: Pipeline Crossing Municipal Road Allowances, Including Irrigation Piping		DATE: April 23, 2019

PURPOSE OF THIS POLICY:

To prevent and/or control damages to municipal roads by regulating all types of pipeline crossings.

POLICY STATEMENT:

The Municipality will allow pipeline crossings of municipal roads under the following guidelines:

- a) crossings are to be made by the punching or boring method only. No open cuts of municipal roads are allowed for any type of crossings.
- b) all pipeline road crossings shall be a minimum of six feet (6') below the crown of the roadway or ERCB standards, whichever is the greater.
- c) all pipeline road crossings shall be a minimum of three feet, six inches (3' 6") below the road ditch or ERCB standards, whichever is the greater.
- d) Pipeline crossing agreements are valid for one year from the date of approval.

Requests for open cutting of any road allowance to accommodate a pipeline crossing must have the prior approval of Council. The Party requesting the cutting of a road allowance shall sign an agreement accepting full responsibility for maintenance and/or repair of said roadway for a period of two years commencing on the date the road cut was done.

Council reserves the right to assess maintenance or repair charges for bored or punched road crossings, against the Party for whom the line was installed, for a period of one year from the date the crossing was installed.

It is the responsibility of the landowner and/or the contractor to contact Alberta First Call for other line locates prior to commencing work, and to notify the Municipality of the location.
