The Municipality will only sell gravel in accordance with the following:

During the Annual Road Re-Gravelling Program

The contractor hired to re-gravel municipal roads will not haul gravel for private lanes at the same time that local roads are being graveled as per council motion 260/19. If a landowner wishes to haul his own gravel, the contractor's loader will load the landowner's truck at whichever pit they are currently operating from. The MD will invoice the landowner for the gravel loaded at the current gravel rate, which is set in the current Fees and Charges Bylaw.

Gravel Sold Throughout the Construction Season from Municipal Pits

Municipal District equipment will not be used to haul gravel for landowners/residents All gravel is to be loaded only by municipal equipment except during the annual road regravelling program and only if the loader is currently at one of the MD's pits, and at the discretion of the Public Works Foreman. A work order will be issued for the amount of gravel loaded for a landowner/resident; loading cost is included in the price of the gravel.

Maximum volume of gravel sold to any ratepayer, person or company in a calendar year is 200 cubic yards (270 tonnes).

Gravel prices have been established as per the current Fees and Charges Bylaw.

Council Motion 270/16 requires the landowner to be responsible for re-gravelling existing approaches.
