PURPOSE OF THIS POLICY:

To provide guidance for traffic signage along municipal roads

POLICY STATEMENT:

The Municipal District of Peace No. 135 follows Alberta Transportation traffic signage guidelines for all signage along municipal roadways.

Administration will complete a Ratepayer Request form for any ratepayer signage requests, which will be taken to Council for a decision. Recommendations for signage by the Public Works Foreman will also be decided by Council. Photos of the proposed sign location should be provided for Council’s information. The MD’s current Road Hierarchy Map will be consulted by Council when signage decisions are being considered.

Where there is no signage at municipal road intersections, drivers must yield the right-of-way to any vehicle on the right, as per Alberta Transportation regulations.

Location of traffic signs:

- to be located 3 metres from the top edge of the gravel road surface (or 6 metres from the painted shoulder line of a paved road surface), unless restricted by physical features.
- height of sign to be between 1.5 – 2.5 metres from road surface to bottom of sign, mounted at right angle to traffic, facing the traffic to which they apply. Wood or steel posts may be used.
