BACKGROUND/PROPOSAL:

Administration received a phone call June 13th regarding fence posts being ripped out/broken by a tractor and disk while the adjacent field was being worked up. The fence posts delineated where the road right of way extended to in order that the developer could seed the right of way before the MD took over the internal subdivision road. The MD and Town of Grimshaw accepted responsibility for the street/road in Pt. SE19-83-23-W5 in 2019. Previous to the fence posts being installed, the adjacent landowner was farming in the MD's right of way. Administration was asked that something be done and that Council should have knowledge of the current situation and/or provide direction to administration as to whether anything further should be done by the MD.


IMPLICATIONS:


- Some farmers do work right into the road right of way along rural roads and the MD has not protested – the farmers get a little more acreage and the weeds are usually taken care of but sometimes the lack of grass cover leads to more erosion of the ditch
- The developer feels he went to a great deal of expense (\$5,000) to have the road surveyed several times (the stakes were removed) before he installed fence posts and was able to complete the road to the MD's satisfaction




